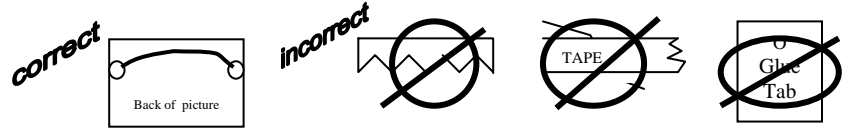

If older they may be disqualified by them at the time of judging. **Works must be framed, ready to hang with fasteners and wire attached.** Use screw eyes available at framing stores (no taping the wire). Art must be in good taste and suitable for family viewing (No nudity or partial nudity).



Paintings not adhering to above rules will be rejected at point of delivery. No heavy or ornate frames. All pictures not to exceed 36" x 48" in size, including frame. Include exhibitor name and phone number on back of article. No kits or paint by number entries in this department.

RULES

- A. Entries must be the work of the exhibitor with exception of processing, mounting, or framing.
- B. Prints of any size, 5" x 7" (minimum) up to 16" x 20" (maximum) are eligible. Frame size should not exceed one inch on the 16" x 20" print size.
- C. All photographs must have been taken within the year preceding the fair.
- D. All photography will be judged by the Danish System of judging.
- E. **Work must be framed and ready to hang with fasteners and wire attached. No gummed hangers allowed, do not tape wire to back of picture.**



- F. Photography not adhering to above rules will be rejected at point of delivery.
- G. **Plain mats and frames are desirable and preferred by the judges, but are not mandatory.**
 Include exhibitor's name, address, and phone on the back of the article.

SECTION 14 – BLACK AND WHITE OR COLOR-Framing Not Mandatory unless noted

Class

1. A black and white or color print sequence of 3 to 5 prints (any size up to 5" x 7" maximum) of any subject. All prints in sequence to be mounted together and ready to hang.
2. A story sequence of 5 to 10 black and white or color pictures on any subject. All prints in sequence to be mounted together and ready to hang.
3. Panoramic – Must be ready to hang.
4. Manipulated Photo – Digital photo manipulated using a computer program.

NOTE: Please check Department 12 (computer science) for manipulated digital pictures.
