DUTY DESCRIPTIONS

EXHIBIT BUILDING MONITOR:

Our exhibit buildings are open from 11:00 am to 10:00 pm daily. We are looking for volunteers that will assist with monitoring the exhibit buildings during fairtime. You make sure no food or drink is brought into the building and people keep their hands off the exhibits. You will volunteer alongside paid staff members who will be responsible for any problems that may arise. If you enjoy interacting with public, this is the perfect place for you. This requires walking throughout building for extended periods of time and answering fairgoers questions about where exhibits are located. There are 4 buildings to choose from: Hall of Flowers, Garrett, Kraft and Finley.

Shift times: 11am- 3pm, 3- 7pm, 6-10pm

PARADE WORKER:

We hold a daily parade around the fairgrounds every day of the Fair. We are looking for volunteers to help out by carrying banners, pulling mini-floats, marching along and encouraging fairgoers to join in. If organizing a drum section or a synchronized stroller unit made up of fairgoers sounds like your cup of tea, this is the volunteer job for you. But if you feel more comfortable quietly carrying a flag, you are just as welcome. Parade Volunteers will be asked to report to the parade staging area at 4:30 p.m. and plan to be available until 5:30—5:45 pm. Volunteers may choose to combine this with another volunteer position..

REPTILE ASSISTANT:

As a part of this year's 'Dinosaur Island' display area, Brad's World Reptiles will be here with a large hands-on display. They are looking for volunteers who are comfortable around reptiles to help out. Your primary duty will be to keep fairgoers from harming the animals, but there will be plenty of time to play with the turtles, as well!
