### Rules

1. This show is recognized by the American Dairy Goat Assn. as an Official Show. Unless other rules are specified the show will be held under the rules of A.D.G.A. provided they do not conflict with any of the rules and regulations prescribed by the Division of Fairs and Expositions of the Department of Food and Agriculture.
2. References to Official A.D.G.A. rules in regards to Official Shows, Championship legs, credits, registry certificates, tattoos, etc., should be carefully reviewed by all exhibitors before the fair. A copy of these rules and regulations are available at the Entry Office for your inspection.
3. ATTENTION RECORDED GRADE EXHIBITORS: Read State IX-Goats 1b, regarding Native on Performance and Native on Appearance.
4. Pre-entry into showmanship is required. Exhibitors must enter showmanship by close of entries. Please see Department 52 for showmanship rules.
5. Show order is subject to change.
6. Please refer to 2023 State Rules, page 24, Sheep and Goat rules for scrapie identification requirements.
7. Breeding Animals Fitting: Changing the natural color of the animal is prohibited. No shadow painting. Exhibitors may use products that enhance the natural color of the animal.
8. No washing of livestock in Lyttle Cow Palace.
9. **STATE RULE: Substitutions can only be made within a division. Substitutions must be made when the exhibit arrives at the fairgrounds. A minimum \$20 penalty must be paid prior to judging for each substitution made by the exhibitor in excess of two in the division.**
