Note:

- **THIS SHOW IS TERMINAL. ALL HOGS JUDGED AND DEEMED MARKET-READY WILL BE SOLD AT THE AUCTION.**
- For security reasons, all livestock barns will be closed, with no access between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. These enforced barn hours will begin on the evening of each market species arrival/check-in day, and continue through the date that each species is transported from the fairgrounds to the processing facility, following the auctions.
- Please have hogs washed before they arrive! Hogs that arrive dirty will be immediately sent to the wash rack.

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Rules

1. Exhibitors will be responsible for bringing their hog from pen to sales ring then back to the pen on the day of the auction. Adult assistance will be provided by the Fair, no parent or leader assistance will be permitted. Exhibitors are responsible for feeding and watering their animals until they are sold at the Auction.
2. Tack will be released Friday, August 4 after 8:00 p.m. Access to water should remain in pens to keep animal hydrated and pens should continue to look presentable through the auction with decorations and educational displays.
3. All Market Hog exhibitors are eligible to enter showmanship. Pre-entry into showmanship is required. Weight or judge sifted animals may be exhibited in showmanship class. All sifted livestock must be removed at conclusion of showmanship.
4. After weighing, market hogs will be divided into weight classes within the specified limitations as desired for convenience in judging. Breed classification is determined at scale.
5. Min weight for any market hog is 220 lbs. Hogs weighing under 220 lbs. will be sifted.
6. Maximum weight is 280 lbs. Any hog weighing over 280 lbs will be sifted at the scale.
7. Gilts exhibited in the market swine Divisions may not be exhibited in the breeding Divisions or vice versa. Any violation of this rule will exclude the exhibitor from competition in all departments of the fair.
8. No clipping will be allowed on the Fairgrounds.
9. **Market Animal Fitting: No hair or skin dyes, paints or colorants (including powder), or adhesives are allowed to be used. No products or materials may be used to manipulate the hair on legs. Exhibitors may continue to use oils or clear coat products to enhance shine as well as external applications of substances for appearance to the hoofs. No shadow painting or practices that change the animal's natural appearance.**
10. All hogs must arrive with fair issued eartags attached to the left ear as you stand behind the hog with the number showing on back of ear. Any hogs unloaded that don't have eartags in ear will be disqualified. **No Exceptions!**
11. The FFA Grand Champion & Reserve Market Hog as well as 4-H Grand Champion & Reserve Market Hog will be diverted to official testing area and tested for drug residue, immediately after the judge selects them in the show ring. For more information see Junior Livestock Auction Rules at the beginning of this Department.
12. Please see Department 52 for showmanship rules.
13. **All hogs must be pre-registered to be eligible at Fair time. Pre-registration does not constitute entry into the Fair. Forms & fees must be completed online by closing deadline.**
14. No feeding/feed dumping in the wash racks.
15. In addition to complying with all the rules above, **Independent Juniors must also have the following items on file with the fairgrounds Entry Office by June 30, 2023:**
 - proof of grade school enrollment/age
 - full photo of the animal
 - proof of ownership

Attention: Market hogs are penned 4 per pen. Please be aware this is a very large show and we do our best to accommodate everyone.

Market Acceptable – U.S. Number 1 and U.S. Number 2 hogs of average or greater conformation that are acceptable in leanness, muscularity and production traits..... Sell

Not Market Acceptable – Any hog of below average conformation including U.S. Number 3 and U.S. Number 4 and utility grade hogs Does not Sell

Rules

1. Open to Barrows and Gilts. Limited to one entry per exhibitor.
2. Pig must have been shown in the Sonoma County Fair Market Show.
3. Pre entry is required. Entry must be submitted online by the close of entries.
4. Open to all exhibitors (*4-H, FFA and Independent Juniors*).
5. Exhibitors must show in whites only.
6. Animals entered must have been bred in Sonoma County (*animals purchased in Sonoma County but not bred and raised are NOT eligible*). Exhibitor must provide proof of eligibility to fair (*all winners will be verified*).
8. Judges placing is final
9. No weight sifted animals are eligible
