### Rules

1. Junior yearling sows must show evidence of farrowing a litter of pigs.
2. Fair will not be requiring blood testing for pesudorabies.
3. Animals exhibited in the breeding show can not be shown in the market show and vice versa.
4. Exhibitors may fill out a breeding partnership with Sonoma County Fair if ALL animals are housed at one physical location. This form must be filled out and completed by the close of entries each year.
5. **STATE RULE:** Substitutions can only be made within a division. Substitutions must be made when the exhibit arrives at the fairgrounds. A minimum \$20 penalty must be paid prior to judging for each substitution made by the exhibitor in excess of two in the division.
