RULES

**Check-in and pick up your number or you will be disqualified.

1. Each team will attempt to milk a wild cow.
2. Each cow will be haltered.
3. **Cows must be out of the chute, and contestants can only hold onto the rope until all four legs of the cow pass the chalk line where milking can begin.**
4. Each team has 2 minutes to milk cow – or time will be called. Cows must remain standing while being milked. No re-runs will be allowed, no exceptions.
5. Cows may not be tied to chute – if the team loses contact with the cow they will be disqualified.
6. All contestants must wear long pants and shirts in order to participate - NO EXCEPTIONS.
7. Contestants will draw for order to go prior to the contest.
8. Each team must be able to run to the judge with the bottle and pour at least one drop of milk out.
9. Fastest time determines placing.
10. Each "team" can only compete once. A contestant can be part of another team.
